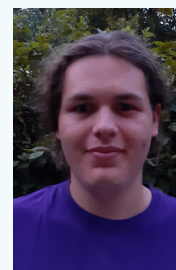

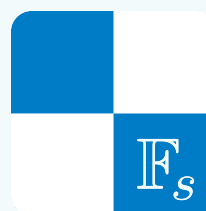
Riddle of the Month

If you throw two dices with n sides and take the maximum of both eye counts as the outcome, what is the expected value? (What changes if you take m dices and what does the maximum look like?)

The solution will be on the next Loo Paper.

Solution of last months riddle:

This works for $Q, Q+\pi, Q+e$. Altogether there are $A \subset [0, 1]$ with $x, y \in A \Rightarrow \exists q \in Q : x + q = y$ and $|A| = |R|$ (This is commonly shown in Ana3). Now $x \in A, x+Q$ are all disjoint and dense.
