

Announcement of Election

November 19, 2019

The election of the “Fachschaftsvertretung” (FSV - Math Student Council) will take place

from 9.12.19 bis to 11.12.19.

The **polling station** will alternate between the **lobbies of Wegelerstraße 10 (We10)** and the **Mathematikzentrum, Endenicher Allee 60 (MZ)**, and will also visit the **lecture hall center, Endenicher Allee 19c (EA19c)**. The voting schedule is as follows:

- 09.12.19: 9:30 – 12:15 (EA19c), 12:45 – 15:30 (MZ),
- 10.12.19: 9:45 – 12:15 (We10), 12:45 – 15:30 (MZ),
- 11.12.19: 9:45 – 12:15 (We10), 12:45 – 15:30 (MZ).

In order to be allowed to vote, students have to present **both their student and photo ID**.

The shared deadline for **Nominations of candidate lists, applications for voting by mail and objections to the electoral register** is

15:00 on 28.11.19.

The FSV will consist of 15 elected members. Nominations need to be handed to the election supervisor in writing, put it in the “Fachschaft”-mailbox or send to his postal address and according to §26 “Fachschaftswahlordnung” (FSWO) contain the following information:

- exactly one name for the list,
- at least one candidature with recognizable total ordering.

According to §15 FSWO a candidature has to contain the following information:

1. family name of the candidate,
2. given name of the candidate,
3. postal address of the candidate,
4. E-Mail-address of the candidate,
5. matriculation number of the candidate,
6. name of the election the nomination is meant for,
7. signature of the candidate.

This year there will be an election magazine where the candidate lists can present themselves. Therefore the candidate lists have the possibility to send four DIN-A4 pages as PDF in grayscale to wahl@fsmath.uni-bonn.de until 29.11.19, 12:00.

Everyone who is immatriculated in a math program (**BSc, MSc or PhD**) **on 9.11.19** and has chosen this program as their primary one concerning elections (only relevant in the case of

multiple majors) is both electable and eligible to vote. Eligibility for this election can be checked on the student ID, where the primary subject is marked with a star (*).

The **electoral register** is publicly available for inspection

from 25.11.19 to 27.11.19

at the counter in the Library of Mathematics, Endenicher Allee 60 during the usual opening hours. **Objections** to the accuracy of the electoral register can be raised **until 28.11.19, 15:00** by contacting the election committee. **After the inspection period is over, only students listed in the electoral register will be allowed to vote.**

Requests for **vote by mail** need be received by the election supervisor **by 28.11.19, 15:00**. Requests have to be justified in writing and contain name, postal address, matriculation number and a remark if personal reception of the documents is desired. The actual vote must be received by the election supervisor before **the end of the voting period (11.12.19, 15:45)**.

This announcement is displayed in the glass cases in front of the “Fachschaft”-office (MZ N0.001) since 19.11.19.

Mode of Election

By §26 FS0 and §8 “Satzung der Fachschaft Mathematik” the election is held as open party-list proportional representation election. A “Fachschaft” makes up an electoral ward. Every eligible student has one vote, which they can give to one whole list or to one individual candidate.

The seat allocation is done by the Sainte-Laguë method, based on the number of votes a list and their candidates got. If there is more than one highest number, the election supervisor decides by lot which list gets the seat. Within a list, the seats are allotted by descending ordering of the number of individual votes a candidate got. When there are an equal number of votes, the election supervisor decides by lot. In case an elected member resigns, the vacant seat will be allotted to the candidate of the same list with the next highest number of votes which was not previously considered. If no such person exists the seat remains empty.

If at any period of time at least half the seats remain empty, new elections take place as soon as possible according to the FSWO. The FSR-chairman immediately convenes a student assembly (FSVV), during which the election date will be decided and the election committee will be elected.
